Squirrel Nutkin's Cuttings

How to grow new plants from root vegetables

You will need:

- Different size glass containers
- Cocktail sticks
- · Jug of water
- · Sharp knife and chopping board
- · Root vegetables such as celery, carrot and radish







Step by step

- An adult will need to chop 3cms off of the root end of the vegetables
- Pop the rest of the vegetable to one side to enjoy later!
- Carefully insert 3 or 4 cocktail sticks into the sides of the root
- Select a glass container and balance the cocktail sticks across the top with the cut side of the vegetable facing downwards
- · Pour water into the container to reach the root and place on a sunny windowsill
- You will be able to watch new tender roots grow into the water over several weeks
- Transplant the new growth into a pot of soil or directly into a flower bed from early summer

NB: Adults supervision required throughout
